

Information on the Processing of Personal Data through Video Surveillance System

2. Purpose of processing and legal basis:

We use a surveillance system for the purpose of protecting individuals, goods, critical facilities and infrastructure. The processing is necessary for the purposes of legitimate interests that we pursue as a data controller (article 6 par. 1. f GDPR).

3. Analysis of legitimate interests

Our legitimate interest exists in the need to protect our premises, and the goods located therein from illegal acts, such as theft. The same applies for the safety, physical integrity, health and property of our staff and third parties who are legally present in the monitored premises. We only collect image data and recording is limited to places that we have assessed as having an increased likelihood of committing illegal acts, without focusing on areas where the privacy of the persons whose image is taken may be unduly restricted, including their right to respect for personal data.

4. Recipients

The recording material kept is accessible only by our competent/authorized personnel who are responsible for the security of the site. This material is not transmitted to third parties, with the exception of the following cases: (a) to the competent judicial, prosecutorial and police authorities where it contains information necessary for the investigation of a criminal offence concerning persons or property of the controller; (b) to the competent judicial, prosecutorial and police authorities when they lawfully request data in the exercise of their duties; and (c) to the victim or perpetrator of a criminal offence, where data may constitute evidence of the offence.

5. Retention period

We retain the data for fifteen (15) days, after which they are automatically deleted. In case we detect an incident during this period, we isolate part of the video and keep it for up to one (1) more month, in order to investigate the incident and initiate legal proceedings to defend our legal interests, while if the incident concerns a third party, we will retain the video for up to three (3) more months.

6. Rights of data subjects

Data subjects have the following rights:

- Right of access: you have the right to know if we are processing your image and, if applicable, to receive a copy of it.
- Right to restriction: you have the right to ask us to restrict processing, such as not to delete data that you consider necessary for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims.

- Right to object: you have the right to object to processing.
- Right to erasure: you have the right to request that we erase your data.

You can exercise your rights by sending an e-mail to dpo@cyprialifegr.com or by post to the Data Protection Officer, 17 Acropolis Avenue, P.C. 2006, Strovolos, Nicosia, Cyprus or by submitting the request to us in person, at the Company's address. To consider a request related to your image, you will need to identify approximately when you were within range of the cameras and provide us with an image of yourself, in order to facilitate our identification of your data and hide the data of third parties depicted. Alternatively, you may come to our premises to show you the images in which you appear. We also point out that exercising the right to object or erasure does not imply the immediate deletion of data or the modification of the processing. In any case, we will respond to your request in detail as soon as possible, within the deadlines set by the GDPR.

7. Right to lodge a complaint

In case you consider that the processing of your data infringes Regulation (EU) 2016/679, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
